Requirements: Fluent in Slovak, Bulgarian and Romanian

Clear Voice is seeking an individual(s) with excellent oral communication skills in Slovak, Bulgarian, and Romanian for a part-time, temporary assignment to conduct a series of timely phone interviews of factory workers. The phone interviews are part of a process to protect the rights of migrant workers in supply chains. The task involves asking selected workers a series of questions related to their workplace conditions and recording the results in a standardized English language template. The individual(s) selected will be fully briefed on proper protocol and will be required to protect the identity of workers and the information they may wish to share.

Background: During the course of audits of workplace conditions, workers are interviewed about conditions of labor. As a follow-up to the interviews, selected workers are asked a series of questions to determine whether they have been subjected to retaliation by management.
